HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE

Read each printed word aloud as you point to it. Students show meaning by finding words that mean the same thing, first by circling and then by drawing matching lines.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

PART 1 • CIRCLE TWINS

SAY “Listen as I read each row. In each row, which word means the same as the word I say?”

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	What word means the same as big? Read: huge, little, wet. Which word will you circle?	huge
b	What word means the same as happy? Read: sad, glad, mad. Which word will you circle?	glad
c	What word means the same as fast? Read: slow, loud, quick. Which word will you circle?	quick

PART 2 • DRAW LINES

SAY “I will read the word on the left and the words on the right. Which word on the right means the same as clean? Which word on the right means the same as begin? Which word on the right means the same as silent? Can you draw a line for each pair?”

- **clean** matches **tidy**
- **begin** matches **start**
- **silent** matches **quiet**

WHAT TO ACCEPT

Circle huge, glad, and quick. Match clean to tidy, begin to start, and silent to quiet. Accept clear lines that connect the correct pairs, even if lines cross.
