A Barrel for Rain

- ① Our school should add a rain barrel near the garden. A rain barrel collects water that falls from the roof. The water can be saved for dry days, when plants need a drink.
- ② First, a rain barrel could help the garden use less water from the hose. Students could fill watering cans with the saved rainwater. Also, the barrel would show students how rain can be collected and used again.
- ③ Rain barrels can have lids that help keep leaves and animals out of the water. They can also have a spout near the bottom, so people can pour water into a can. For these reasons, our school should add a rain barrel.
