1	Who is the main character, and where does the story happen?	The main character is Mina. The story happens in the grassy field behind her apartment.
2	What problem does Mina face in the middle of the story?	A gust pulls the kite string from Mina's hands, and the kite lands in a tree.
3	How is the problem solved at the end?	Mina uses a long cardboard tube to lift the kite from the tree, then she flies it again.
