The Clear Path

- ① On Saturday, Nia carried her red wagon to the park for the block cleanup. A tall pile of sticks lay near the path. Nia tried to pull the pile alone, but the sticks rolled away each time.
- ② Her neighbor Bo saw Nia frown. He brought a rake, and Nia asked Kim to hold open a yard bag. Bo raked the sticks into a heap while Nia lifted them. Soon, the path was clear.
- ③ Nia looked at the clean path and smiled at Bo and Kim. "I could not do that by myself," she said. The three children used the wagon to carry the full bag to the bin.

1	What is a theme of "The Clear Path"? Write the message in a full sentence.	Working together can make a hard job easier.
2	Which two actions in the story show the theme?	Bo brings a rake and rakes the sticks into a heap. Nia asks Kim to hold open the yard bag while she lifts the sticks.
3	How does Nia's sentence at the end help explain the theme?	Nia says she could not clear the sticks by herself, showing that the children succeeded by working together.

PART 3 • YOUR TURN (SAMPLE ANSWER)

Leo could not carry a box of art paper to the supply table. He asked Sana to hold one side of the box. Together, they moved it before class began. The theme is that asking for help can solve a problem because Leo and Sana carried the box together.
