The Garden Gate

- ① On Saturday, Mina brought her new red kite to the park. A strong wind pulled the string from her hand. The kite landed behind the locked community garden gate, and Mina felt worried.
- ② Mina asked the gardener, Mr. Lee, for help. He opened the gate, but the kite was caught high in a tomato plant. Mina gently lifted the string while Mr. Lee held the plant still.
- ③ The kite came free without breaking the plant. Mina thanked Mr. Lee and flew her kite in the open field. She learned to hold the string tightly when the wind blew.

1	What problem does Mina have at the beginning of the story?	Her kite blows behind a locked garden gate.
2	What do Mr. Lee and Mina do to get the kite free? Tell the actions in order.	Mr. Lee opens the gate. Mina lifts the string while Mr. Lee holds the tomato plant still.
3	How does the story end, and what does Mina learn?	The kite comes free, and Mina learns to hold the string tightly when the wind blows.

PART 3 • YOUR TURN (SAMPLE ANSWER)

Mina took her red kite to the park, but it blew behind a locked garden gate. Mr. Lee opened the gate, and Mina gently lifted the kite string. The kite came free, and Mina thanked Mr. Lee. She learned to hold the string tightly in strong wind.
