A Tide Pool Visit

- ① At low tide, Maya visited a rocky shore with her uncle. Small pools of seawater were left between the rocks. Her uncle told her to move gently because the pools were shelters, or safe places, for tiny animals. Maya spotted a crab tucked under brown seaweed. It stayed still until a wave splashed nearby. The water rippled.
- ② Maya wanted to inspect the crab without touching it. To inspect means to look closely and carefully. She noticed its legs were striped, and one claw was larger than the other. A gull landed on a rock above the pool. The crab quickly slipped into a narrow crack, where the bird could not reach it.
- ③ Before leaving, Maya and her uncle gathered scattered bits of plastic from the shore. Scattered means spread out in many places. They placed the trash in a bag so it would not wash into the pools. Maya understood that protecting a habitat means keeping the animals' home safe and clean for the creatures that live there.
