A Clearer Trail

- ① At Pine Ridge Park, volunteers built a new trail through a wet meadow. Before opening day, Maya walked the route with a map. She paused at a narrow bend where the path turned beside a creek. A wooden post stood there, but its faded arrow was hard to read. Maya made a note to replace the sign before visitors arrived.
- ② Later, Maya met Luis near the tool shed. He carried a bucket of bright paint and a small brush. "We need a bold color," he said, "so hikers can spot the arrow from far away." They chose orange, then coated the post with two layers. When the paint dried, the arrow looked sharp against the gray wood.
- ③ On Saturday, the first group of hikers followed the trail. At the bend, they stopped without confusion and crossed the small bridge. One child pointed to the orange arrow and said it was easy to notice. Maya smiled. The fresh sign did more than show direction, it helped the group stay on the safe path and enjoy the meadow.

1	What does bend mean in paragraph 1? Which words help you know?	A curved turn in the path. The clue is “where the path turned beside a creek.”
2	What does bold mean in the phrase “a bold color”?	Bright or easy to notice. The clue is that hikers could spot the arrow from far away.
3	What does coated mean in paragraph 2? Use a detail from the passage to explain.	Covered with paint. The post was covered with two layers of paint.
4	What does sharp mean when the arrow “looked sharp against the gray wood”?	Clear and easy to see. The orange arrow stood out against the gray wood.

PART 3 • YOUR TURN (SAMPLE ANSWER)
