HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE

Read each short source aloud twice, then read one question at a time. Students use information from the source to answer a question, which is an early research skill.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

PART 1 • ANT FACTS

SAY “We are researching ants. Listen twice: Ants have six legs, live in colonies, and eat seeds. Use these facts to answer each question I ask.”

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	How many legs does an ant have? The choices are four, six, and eight. Circle the number that answers our question.	six
b	Where do ants live? The choices are cave, nest, and colony. Circle the word that answers our question.	colony
c	What do ants eat? The choices are seeds, leaves, and meat. Circle the word that answers our question.	seeds

PART 2 • WORM FACTS

SAY “Now we are researching worms. Listen twice: Worms have no legs, and many worms live in soil. In the first box, how many legs do worms have? In the second box, where do many worms live? Write your answers.”

- Box 1 (beside Legs): **0**
- Box 2 (beside Home): **soil**

WHAT TO ACCEPT

Ant Facts answers are six, colony, and seeds. Accept 0 or a clearly written zero for the first Worm Facts box, and accept a readable tracing or copying of soil for the second box.
