HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE

Read each row prompt aloud and give students time to circle one large letter. Then read the matching directions and have students draw lines from each capital letter to its lowercase match. This sheet checks whether students can recognize letter names and connect uppercase and lowercase forms.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

PART 1 • CIRCLE IT

SAY “Listen as I read the letters in each row. Which letter do you hear named? Circle it.”

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	The letters are M, W, and N. Which letter is M? Circle it.	M
b	The letters are L, T, and I. Which letter is T? Circle it.	T
c	The letters are H, E, and F. Which letter is F? Circle it.	F

PART 2 • MATCH LETTERS

SAY “Look at the capital letters on the left and the lowercase letters on the right. Can you draw a line from each capital letter to the lowercase letter that matches it?”

- **P** matches **p**
- **R** matches **r**
- **S** matches **s**

WHAT TO ACCEPT

Circle M in row 1, T in row 2, and F in row 3. Match P to p, R to r, and S to s.
