**HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE**

Read each question aloud and give students time to mark their answers. In Part 2, students can use an addition fact to find the missing part after a number is taken away.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

**PART 1 • ADD IT**

**SAY** “Listen to each adding question and the number choices. Can you circle the number that answers each question?”

| ROW | SAY                                                                               | STUDENTS CIRCLE |
|-----|-----------------------------------------------------------------------------------|-----------------|
| a   | What is 7 plus 5? The choices are 11, 12, and 13. Which number should you circle? | <b>12</b>       |
| b   | What is 9 plus 8? The choices are 16, 15, and 17. Which number should you circle? | <b>17</b>       |
| c   | What is 6 plus 6? The choices are 12, 11, and 13. Which number should you circle? | <b>12</b>       |

**PART 2 • TAKE AWAY**

**SAY** “For 16, if you take away 7, how many are left, and what number makes 7 plus that number equal 16? For 14, if you take away 8, how many are left, and what number makes 8 plus that number equal 14? For 12, if you take away 5, how many are left, and can you draw lines to the matching numbers?”

- **16** matches **9**
- **14** matches **6**
- **12** matches **7**

**WHAT TO ACCEPT**

Part 1 answers are 12, 17, and 12. Part 2 lines should match 16 to 9, 14 to 6, and 12 to 7.
