EQUAL MEANS SAME

The equal sign means both sides have the same amount. Find the missing number by thinking about what you add or take away to make the amounts match.

WORKED EXAMPLE

9 shells + ____ shells = 16 shells

1. Start with 9 shells.
2. Count on from 9 to 16.
3. You count 7 more shells.
4. Write $9 + 7 = 16$.

Answer: 7
