THE BIG IDEA

Ten more means add 10. Ten less means take away 10. One hundred more or less means add or take away 100.

WORKED EXAMPLE

A bin has 386 blocks. What is 100 less than 386?

1. Start with 386.
2. Take away 100.
3. $386 - 100 = 286$.

Answer: 286
