CHECK BOTH SIDES

An equation has two sides. Find the value on each side, then compare them. If the values match, the equation is true. If they do not match, it is false.

WORKED EXAMPLE

$$32 / 4 = 3 * 3$$

1. Find the left side: $32 / 4 = 8$.
2. Find the right side: $3 * 3 = 9$.
3. Compare 8 and 9. They are not equal.

Answer: False

#	PROBLEM	ANSWER
1	$6 * 6 = 36$. Is the equation true or false? Show the value of each side.	True. $36 = 36$.
2	$25 / 5 = 6$. Is the equation true or false? Show the value of each side.	False. 5 does not equal 6.
3	$7 * 5 = 35$. Is the equation true or false? Show the value of each side.	True. $35 = 35$.
4	$42 / 7 = 30 / 5$. Is the equation true or false? Show the value of each side.	True. $6 = 6$.
5	$10 * 7 = 69$. Is the equation true or false? Show the value of each side.	False. 70 does not equal 69.
6	$72 / 6 = 66 / 11$. Is the equation true or false? Show the value of each side.	True. $12 = 12$.

PART 2 • APPLY IT

- False. $5 * 7 = 35$, not 36.** Multiply 5 by 7 to find 35 players. Since 35 is not 36, the equation is false.
- True. $55 / 5 = 11$.** Divide 55 by 5 to find 11 cards in each pocket. Both sides have a value of 11, so the equation is true.

CHALLENGE

C is false. $42 / 7 = 6$, not 5.
