LINE UP PLACE VALUES

Line up digits by place value before you add or subtract. Work from the ones place to the left. Regroup when a sum is 10 or more, or trade from the next place when subtracting.

WORKED EXAMPLE

$$3,472 + 1,658$$

1. Ones: $2 + 8 = 10$. Write 0 and regroup 1 ten.
2. Tens: $7 + 5 + 1 = 13$. Write 3 and regroup 1 hundred.
3. Hundreds: $4 + 6 + 1 = 11$. Write 1 and regroup 1 thousand.
4. Thousands: $3 + 1 + 1 = 5$.

Answer: 5,130
