CHECK BOTH SIDES

An equation is true when the value on the left side equals the value on the right side. Solve each side carefully, then compare the values. If they match, the equation is true. If they do not match, it is false.

WORKED EXAMPLE

$$48 - 15 = 33$$

1. Solve the left side: $48 - 15 = 33$.
2. Compare the two sides: $33 = 33$.
3. The sides match.

Answer: True

Is $(56 / 7) + 13 = 4 * 5 + 1$ true or false? Explain how you checked both sides.

#	PROBLEM	ANSWER
1	Is $36 + 27 = 63$ true or false? Show the value of each side.	True; $36 + 27 = 63$, so both sides equal 63.
2	Is $84 - 29 = 56$ true or false? Show the value of each side.	False; $84 - 29 = 55$, and 55 does not equal 56.
3	Is $7 * 8 = 54$ true or false? Show the value of each side.	False; $7 * 8 = 56$, and 56 does not equal 54.
4	Is $72 / 9 = 8$ true or false? Show the value of each side.	True; $72 / 9 = 8$, so both sides equal 8.
5	Is $125 + 75 = 190$ true or false? Show the value of each side.	False; $125 + 75 = 200$, and 200 does not equal 190.
6	Is $96 / 12 = 8$ true or false? Show the value of each side.	True; $96 / 12 = 8$, so both sides equal 8.

PART 2 • APPLY IT

- False; $9 * 7 = 63$, not 56.** Multiply 9 by 7 to find the total number of cards. The left side is 63, so the equation is false.
- False; $144 / 12 = 12$, not 11.** Divide 144 by 12 to find the number of prize bags. The left side is 12, so the equation is false.

CHALLENGE

True; $(56 / 7) + 13 = 8 + 13 = 21$, and $4 * 5 + 1 = 20 + 1 = 21$.

Accept true or false only when it is supported by correct values for both sides. Students may show work in a different order if their calculations and comparison are correct.
