THREE WAYS TO SHOW A NUMBER

Standard form uses digits and commas. Expanded form shows the value of each nonzero digit added together, and word form names the number. Zeros hold places but do not need to be written in expanded form.

WORKED EXAMPLE

Write 508,307 in expanded form and word form.

1. The nonzero digits show 5 hundred-thousands, 8 thousands, 3 hundreds, and 7 ones.
2. Write the place values as an addition sentence: $500,000 + 8,000 + 300 + 7$.
3. Write the number in words by naming the thousands period, then the ones period.

Answer: Expanded form: $500,000 + 8,000 + 300 + 7$. Word form: five hundred eight thousand, three hundred seven.
