LINE UP THE PLACES

Write numbers so the decimal points are directly above each other. Add or subtract each place value from right to left, regrouping when needed.

WORKED EXAMPLE

$$47.38 + 16.45$$

1. Line up the decimal points.
2. Add hundredths: $8 + 5 = 13$. Write 3 and regroup 1 tenth.
3. Add tenths: $3 + 4 + 1 = 8$.
4. Add the whole numbers: $47 + 16 = 63$.

Answer: 63.83

PART 2 • APPLY IT

1. **\$16.48** Add the two costs: $\$18.67 + \$9.85 = \$28.52$. Subtract $\$28.52$ from $\$45.00$.

CHALLENGE
