MATCH THE MATH

Words such as sum, difference, product, and quotient tell you which operation to use. Phrases such as "the difference between" and "the sum of" show which numbers belong together, so use parentheses when needed. When you write words for an expression, name the operations and make the grouping clear.

WORKED EXAMPLE

Write a numerical expression for:
18 minus the product of 4 and 3.

1. The product of 4 and 3 is written as 4×3 .
2. The phrase says to subtract that product from 18.
3. Use parentheses to keep the product together: $18 - (4 \times 3)$.

Answer: $18 - (4 \times 3)$

1	Write a numerical expression for: the sum of 27 and 15, divided by 6.	$(27 + 15) / 6$
2	Write a numerical expression for: 9 times the difference between 20 and 7.	$9 \times (20 - 7)$
3	Write a numerical expression for: the quotient of 56 and 8, plus 11.	$56 / 8 + 11$
4	Write a mathematical description for: $(34 - 12) \times 5$	Five times the difference between 34 and 12.

PART 2 • APPLY IT

1. $16 \times 7 - 9 = 103$ Multiply 16 by 7 to find the points earned. Subtract the 9 penalty points.
2. $48 / 6 + 12 = 20$ Divide 48 stickers among 6 bags. Add 12 bonus stickers to each bag.

$$(14 \times 9) / (17 - 11) = 21$$
