CHECK BOTH SIDES

An equation is true when the value on the left side equals the value on the right side. Find each side's value, then compare the two values before you decide.

WORKED EXAMPLE

$$52 \div 4 + 11 = 24$$

1. $52 \div 4 = 13$.
2. $13 + 11 = 24$.
3. The left side is 24.
4. 24 equals 24, so the equation is true.

1	1. Is $38 + 27 = 65$ true or false?	True
2	2. Is $84 - 39 = 46$ true or false?	False, because $84 - 39 = 45$.
3	3. Is $9 * 8 = 70$ true or false?	False, because $9 * 8 = 72$.
4	4. Is $96 / 12 = 8$ true or false?	True
5	5. Is $45 + 18 = 70$ true or false?	False, because $45 + 18 = 63$.
6	6. Is $144 / 12 - 5 = 7$ true or false?	True

PART 2 • APPLY IT

1. **False. $125 / 5 = 25$, not 30.** Divide 125 by 5 to find the number of cards in each binder. The result is 25, so the equation is false.
2. **True. $32 * 6 = 192$.** Multiply 32 by 6. Both sides have a value of 192, so the equation is true.

CHALLENGE

True. $150 - 48 = 102$, and $102 + 15 = 117$.

Accept "true" or "false" with correct calculations. For explanations, accept any clear comparison showing the value of both sides.
