MULTIPLY IN PLACE

Multiply by each digit in the bottom factor, starting with the ones digit. Write each partial product in the correct place value, then add the partial products.

WORKED EXAMPLE

$$326 \times 47$$

1. $326 \times 7 = 2,282$

2. $326 \times 40 = 13,040$

3. $2,282 + 13,040 = 15,322$

Answer: 15,322
