ESTIMATE, THEN CALCULATE

Estimate by rounding a decimal to a nearby whole number or a compatible number. To multiply, multiply as whole numbers, then use place value to put the decimal point in the product. For division, use a compatible number to estimate, then divide the exact decimal carefully.

WORKED EXAMPLE

Estimate, then solve: 3.47×6

1. Round 3.47 to 3.5: $3.5 \times 6 = 21$.
2. Multiply without the decimal: $347 \times 6 = 2,082$.
3. 47 has 2 decimal places, so 2,082 becomes 20.82.

Answer: Estimate: 21; exact product: 20.82

2. **Estimate: 5 meters; exact length: 5.04 meters** Round 45.36 to 45, then divide 45 by 9 to estimate. Divide 45.36 by 9 for the exact length.
