CHOOSE A SMART METHOD

Line up digits by place value when you add or subtract. For multiplication, use partial products. For division, divide carefully and check by multiplying the quotient by the divisor.

WORKED EXAMPLE

$$3,624 \times 15$$

1. Multiply by ones: $3,624 \times 5 = 18,120$.
2. Multiply by tens: $3,624 \times 10 = 36,240$.
3. Add the partial products: $18,120 + 36,240 = 54,360$.

Answer: 54,360
