INTEGER MOVES

To add integers with different signs, subtract the smaller absolute value from the larger absolute value and use the sign of the number farther from zero. To subtract an integer, add its opposite, then use the addition rule.

WORKED EXAMPLE

$$-36 + 19$$

1. The signs are different, so subtract the absolute values.
2. $36 - 19 = 17$.
3. 36 has the greater absolute value, and it is negative.
4. $-36 + 19 = -17$

Answer: -17
