INTEGER OPERATION RULES

To add integers with different signs, subtract their absolute values and use the sign of the number farther from zero. To subtract an integer, add its opposite. For multiplication and division, matching signs give a positive answer, and different signs give a negative answer.

WORKED EXAMPLE

Find: $-14 + 12$

1. The signs are different, so subtract: $14 - 12 = 2$.
2. The larger absolute value is 14, and it is negative.
3. The sum is -2.

Answer: -2

1. **-1 point** Compute $18 - 25 + 6$. The final score is -1 point.
