MA.8.NSO.1.4 "Express numbers in scientific notation to represent and approximate very large or very small quantities. Determine how many times larger or smaller one number is compared to a second number."

SCIENTIFIC NOTATION STEPS

Scientific notation has a number from 1 to less than 10 multiplied by a power of 10. Move the decimal left for a positive exponent and right for a negative exponent. To compare two numbers, divide the larger quantity by the smaller quantity.

WORKED EXAMPLE

Write 72,000,000 in scientific notation.

1. Place the decimal after the first nonzero digit: 7.2
2. Count 7 places from 72,000,000 to 7.2.
3. The decimal moved left, so use a positive exponent: 7.2×10^7 .

Answer: 7.2×10^7

CHALLENGE One step up

CHALLENGE

A student says that 6.4×10^{-5} is 1,000 times larger than 8×10^{-8} because the exponents differ by 3. Is the student correct? Explain your reasoning and state the correct factor.

PART 2 • APPLY IT

- 800 times larger** Divide 2.4×10^{10} by 3×10^7 . The result is 0.8×10^3 , which equals 800.
- $0.016 = 1.6 \times 10^{-2}$; $0.00025 = 2.5 \times 10^{-4}$; 64 times as often** Write the times as 1.6×10^{-2} and 2.5×10^{-4} . Divide 1.6×10^{-2} by 2.5×10^{-4} to get 64, so the smaller time interval means 64 times as many photos.

CHALLENGE

No. $(6.4 \times 10^{-5}) / (8 \times 10^{-8}) = (6.4 / 8) \times 10^3 = 0.8 \times 1,000 = 800$, so 6.4×10^{-5} is 800 times larger.

Accept equivalent standard-form answers with correct zeros and equivalent scientific notation with a coefficient from 1 to less than 10. For comparison items, accept equivalent wording such as "500 times as large" or "a factor of 500."
