CHOOSE MULTIPLY OR DIVIDE

When a rate gives foreign currency per dollar, multiply the number of dollars by the rate. When you are converting that foreign currency back to dollars, divide by the rate. Track the currency unit that remains after each calculation.

WORKED EXAMPLE

An exchange booth quotes 4.8 zeds per dollar. Convert \$35 to zeds.

1. Write the conversion: $\$35 \times 4.8$ zeds per dollar.
2. Cancel dollars and multiply: $35 \times 4.8 = 168$.
3. The remaining unit is zeds.

Answer: 168 zeds

CHALLENGE One step up

CHALLENGE

During a trip, Kai exchanges \$60 at a rate of 8 Mexican pesos per US dollar. The kiosk keeps a 15% fee from the pesos received. Kai then exchanges the remaining pesos at 6 Mexican pesos per euro. How many euros does Kai receive?

PART 2 • APPLY IT

- Yes, 6 euros will be left.** Convert \$80 to euros: $80 \times 0.75 = 60$ euros. Subtract the ticket cost: $60 - 54 = 6$ euros.
- \$22** Convert yen to dollars: $4,000 / 160 = \$25$. Subtract the \$3 fee: $25 - 3 = \$22$.

CHALLENGE

68 euros

Accept correct currency symbols or currency names. For the challenge, students should find 480 pesos, subtract a 72-peso fee, and convert 408 pesos to 68 euros.
