HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE

Read each row prompt aloud and let students circle one large number. Then read the matching direction aloud as students connect each number to the number that makes 10 with it.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

PART 1 • CIRCLE IT

SAY “We will find the number that joins a number I say to make 10. Listen to each question, then circle one number in that row.”

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	Look at 5, 6, and 7. Which number can join 4 to make 10? Circle it.	6
b	Look at 1, 3, and 4. Which number can join 7 to make 10? Circle it.	3
c	Look at 2, 1, and 4. Which number can join 8 to make 10? Circle it.	2

PART 2 • DRAW LINES

SAY “Look at the numbers on the left and the right. Which number on the right can join each left number to make 10? Draw a line to each match.”

- **1** matches **9**
- **5** matches **5**
- **9** matches **1**

WHAT TO ACCEPT

Circle row answers are 6, 3, and 2. Match 1 to 9, 5 to 5, and 9 to 1.
