HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE

Read each shape sequence slowly, in the order given, and then read the position-word choices. Students identify where the named shape comes in the sequence and circle its position word.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

PART 1 • LISTEN AND CIRCLE

SAY “Listen as I say each shape name in order. Then listen to the question and circle one position word.”

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	Listen in order: circle, square, triangle. What place is the circle? Your choices are first, second, and third.	first
b	Listen in order: triangle, oval, star, square. What place is the star? Your choices are second, third, and fourth.	third
c	Listen in order: hexagon, diamond, rectangle, oval. What place is the oval? Your choices are third, fourth, and second.	fourth

PART 2 • KEEP LISTENING

SAY “Listen carefully to each longer shape sequence. Circle the position word that tells where the named shape comes in the order.”

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	Listen in order: circle, square, triangle, star, oval. What place is the oval? Your choices are fourth, fifth, and third.	fifth
b	Listen in order: diamond, hexagon, oval, triangle, star. What place is the hexagon? Your choices are first, second, and third.	second
c	Listen in order: rectangle, pentagon, circle, diamond, oval. What place is the diamond? Your choices are fifth, third, and fourth.	fourth

WHAT TO ACCEPT

Accept a circle around the correct position word for each row. Answers are first, third, fourth, fifth, second, and fourth, in order.
