CHECK THE THINKING

Solve the problem, then check it a different way. When you discuss an answer, say if you agree and use math to tell why.

WORKED EXAMPLE

A snack table has 17 apples and 26 oranges. Ben says there are 43 pieces of fruit. Check Ben's thinking.

1. Add $17 + 20 = 37$.
2. Add $37 + 6 = 43$.
3. Check: $43 - 26 = 17$.
4. Ben's answer checks.

Answer: Ben is correct. There are 43 pieces of fruit.

CHALLENGE

A game fundraiser earns 128 points in round one and 76 points in round two. Nia says the total is 194. Eli says the total is 204. Who is correct? Explain why.

#	PROBLEM	ANSWER
1	Lena has 34 stickers and gets 27 more. Kai says $34 + 27 = 51$. Is Kai correct? Show a check.	No. $34 + 27 = 61$. Check: $34 + 20 + 7 = 61$.
2	At recess, 63 kids are playing. Nineteen go inside. Omar says $63 - 19 = 44$. Check Omar's answer.	Omar is correct. $63 - 20 + 1 = 44$.
3	A comic shelf has 46 comics. Nine are borrowed. Priya says 37 are left. Is her answer reasonable? Explain.	Yes. $46 - 9 = 37$, and $37 + 9 = 46$.
4	A class earns 25 points Monday and 38 points Tuesday. Theo adds $20 + 30$ and $5 + 8$. What should Theo say?	Theo should say the class earned 63 points. $20 + 30 = 50$ and $5 + 8 = 13$, so $50 + 13 = 63$.
5	Noah has 72 beads and uses 36. He says, "I subtracted 30, then 6, and got 36." Check his thinking.	Noah is correct. $72 - 30 = 42$ and $42 - 6 = 36$.

PART 2 • APPLY IT

- Jada is correct. The club needs 38 more batteries.** Subtract $85 - 47 = 38$. Check by adding $47 + 38 = 85$.
- Ava is correct. 53 buttons remain.** Subtract 30, then 7: $90 - 30 = 60$ and $60 - 7 = 53$.

CHALLENGE

Eli is correct. $128 + 76 = 204$. Regroup $8 + 6 = 14$, then $2 + 7 + 1 = 10$, so the hundreds total is 2.

Accept clear equivalent checking strategies, such as addition to check subtraction. Students should name whether they agree or disagree and support the claim with correct math.
