HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE

Read every word choice aloud, then give students time to make each mark. Students show the skill by recognizing living things on Earth's surface and by matching common Earth materials with words that describe them.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

PART 1 • CIRCLE LIFE

SAY "Listen to the words in each row. Circle the word that names a living thing found on Earth's surface."

a	Which word names a living thing found on Earth's surface: tree, water, or rock?	tree
b	Which word names a living thing found on Earth's surface: soil, worm, or cloud?	worm
c	Which word names a living thing found on Earth's surface: star, soil, or ant?	ant
