HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE

Read every question and choice aloud, giving students time to circle one answer in each row. The skill is shown when students use daytime and nighttime choices correctly after hearing each question about the Sun.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

PART 1 • SUN TIME

SAY "I will read the choices in each row. Listen to the question, then circle one big word."

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	I will read the choices: daytime, nighttime, both. The Sun can be seen only during which time? Circle your answer.	DAYTIME
b	I will read the choices: yes, no, both. It is nighttime. Can you see the Sun? Circle your answer.	NO
c	I will read the choices: no, both, yes. Is daytime the time when the Sun can be seen? Circle your answer.	YES

PART 2 • SKY CLUES

SAY "Now listen for a clue about the sky. I will read the choices, then you will circle the time that fits the clue."

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	I will read the choices: nighttime, daytime, both. You look up and see the Sun. Is it nighttime, daytime, or both? Circle your answer.	DAYTIME
b	I will read the choices: no, both, yes. Can the Sun be seen at nighttime? Circle your answer.	NO
