PART 1 • LISTEN AND CIRCLE

SAY "Listen to each clue and the names in the row. Circle the last name that answers each question."

a	James Earl Jones was an actor with a well-known voice. The names are White, Franklin, and Jones. Which last name belongs to James Earl Jones?	Jones
b	Maya Angelou was a poet and writer. The names are White, Angelou, and Franklin. Which last name belongs to Maya Angelou?	Angelou
c	Charles White made a portrait of Abraham Lincoln. The names are White, Jones, and Franklin. Which last name belongs to Charles White?	White
