Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

PART 1 • CIRCLE IT

SAY “Listen to each short story and the three words in its row. Circle the word that answers the question.”

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	A student stands quietly and respectfully during the Pledge of Allegiance. Does this show care for our country? Circle YES, NO, or MAYBE.	YES
