Saturday Market

- ① On Saturday, Maya set up a table at the town market. She had made colorful friendship bracelets. A bracelet is a good because a person can take it home. Maya wanted to earn money so she could buy a new soccer ball. People who wanted bracelets stopped at her table. They were buyers, and Maya was the seller.
- ② Jordan chose a blue bracelet and asked its price. Maya said it cost three dollars. Jordan gave Maya three dollars, and Maya gave Jordan the bracelet. Money helped them make the exchange. Jordan got the good he wanted. Maya got money she could use later. Both the buyer and seller took part in the exchange.
- ③ Nearby, Mr. Lee offered a service. He could sharpen dull pencils for customers. Ava had no money with her, but she had a small apple from her lunch. Mr. Lee agreed to trade: he sharpened Ava's pencils, and Ava gave him the apple. Trade happens when buyers and sellers exchange goods or services without using money.
