Labels for a Globe

- ① North America has three large countries named Canada, the United States, and Mexico. Canada is north of the United States, and Mexico is south of the United States. Canada and Mexico each share a border with the United States. These country names are labels people can place on a map of North America. Reading the labels helps travelers talk about locations clearly.
- ② The Caribbean is a region with islands and island countries. Puerto Rico is a commonwealth of the United States in the Caribbean. Cuba, the Bahamas, the Dominican Republic, Haiti, and Jamaica are Caribbean countries. Their names are important map labels. Although these places are close to one another, each has its own location, people, government, and history.
- ③ For this labeling task, make two groups for an imaginary class globe. Put Canada, the United States, and Mexico in a North America group. Put Puerto Rico, Cuba, Bahamas, Dominican Republic, Haiti, and Jamaica in a Caribbean group. Check each label carefully. A correct group shows whether a place belongs in the North America group or the Caribbean group. Puerto Rico is called a commonwealth, while the other listed Caribbean places are countries.
