HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE

Read each sentence exactly as written in the prompts, including the word that does not fit. Students listen for the problem, check the printed choices, and reread the sentence with a word that makes sense.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

PART 1 • CHECK MEANING

SAY “I will read a sentence with a word that does not make sense. Say the sentence softly after me, stop when it sounds wrong, look at the three words, and reread the sentence in your mind. Which word makes sense? Circle it.”

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	I said, “The cap can nap.” Which word makes sense in this sentence? Circle it.	cat
b	I said, “I can fun.” Which word makes sense in this sentence? Circle it.	run
c	I said, “The dig is big.” Which word makes sense in this sentence? Circle it.	dog

PART 2 • REREAD IT

SAY “This time, I will read each sentence once with a word that sounds wrong. Read the three words softly, choose one, then whisper the whole fixed sentence again. Which word will you circle?”

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	I said, “My hot is red.” Which word makes sense when you reread the sentence? Circle it.	hat
b	I said, “Sam uses a mop to find the park.” Which word makes sense when you reread the sentence? Circle it.	map
c	I said, “The sun is us.” Which word makes sense when you reread the sentence? Circle it.	up

WHAT TO ACCEPT

Part 1 answers are cat, run, dog. Part 2 answers are hat, map, up. Accept each circled word and an oral rereading of the corrected sentence.
