HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE

Read each part aloud and give students time to make one mark at a time. Watch for letters that start in the correct place, use clear lines and curves, and keep a similar size when repeated.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

PART 1 • LETTER PARTNERS

SAY “Look at the capital letters on the left and the small letters on the right. Which small letter is the partner for each capital letter? Draw a line to show each match.”

- **M** matches **m**
- **T** matches **t**
- **S** matches **s**

PART 2 • TRACE PATHS

SAY “Can you trace each gray model slowly and carefully? Can you make the repeated letters and word look alike?”

- Box 1: **B B**
- Box 2: **b b**
- Box 3: **bat bat**

WHAT TO ACCEPT

Matches are M to m, T to t, and S to s. Accept traced forms that are recognizable and follow the gray models, with repeated letters or words formed similarly in size and shape.
