HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE

Read each part aloud and give students time to mark the page. Students show basic transcription skills by connecting matching capital and lowercase letters, then tracing the printed words from left to right.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

PART 1 • MATCH LETTERS

SAY “The capital letters are on the left. The small letters are on the right. Can you draw a line from each capital letter to the same small letter?”

- **M** matches **m**
- **S** matches **s**
- **A** matches **a**

PART 2 • TRACE WORDS

SAY “Each box has a gray word. Can you trace over each word, starting at the first letter and moving to the last letter?”

- Box 1: **sun**
- Box 2: **map**
- Box 3: **top**

WHAT TO ACCEPT

Accept lines M to m, S to s, and A to a. Accept traced words when the student follows the gray letter shapes in left-to-right order, with reasonable first-grade letter formation.
