HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE

Read the scripts aloud, but do not read any printed word choices aloud. Students should sound out the letters and blend the sounds before marking. During tracing, listen for students to say each sound and blend the whole nonsense word.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

PART 1 • SOUND HUNT

SAY “Look at the printed words in each row. Can you touch under each letter, say the sounds softly, blend them, and circle the word I ask for?”

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	Which printed word says /v/ /ă/ /b/? Circle it.	vab
b	Which printed word says /ě/ /b/? Circle it.	eb
c	Which printed word says /g/ /l/ /ă/ /p/? Circle it.	glap

PART 2 • TRACE READ

SAY “Look at the gray word in each box. Can you touch under its letters, say its sounds, read the whole silly word, and trace it?”

- Box 1: **mape**
- Box 2: **elb**
- Box 3: **snuP**

WHAT TO ACCEPT

Circle-row answers are vab, eb, and glap. Accept tracing with recognizable letters in the correct order, and listen for sound-by-sound blending of each gray word.
