HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE

Read each prompt aloud and give students time to point to or circle a choice. In the writing part, dictate each word and have students stretch the sounds before writing the regular spelling.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

PART 1 • CIRCLE WORDS

SAY "I will read the words in each row and ask a question. Listen closely, then circle the word that answers the question."

a	The words are on, in, and at. Which word completes this sentence: I am ___ the tent? Circle it.	in
b	The words are mule, mile, and mole. Which word names an animal that can pull a cart? Circle it.	mule
c	The words are step, stem, and stop. Which word means to quit moving? Circle it.	stop

PART 2 • WRITE WORDS

SAY "In the first box, what letters spell map? Say /m/ /a/ /p/, then write the word. In the next box, what letters spell ant? Say /a/ /n/ /t/, then write the word. In the last box, what letters spell stand? Say /s/ /t/ /a/ /n/ /d/, then write the word."

- Box 1: **map**
