HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE

Tell students that a verb can show something happening now, something that happened before, or something that will happen later. Model with a different verb: "I dance now. I danced before. I will dance later." Read every choice aloud because students are not expected to read the words independently.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

PART 1 • CIRCLE IT

SAY "Listen to each sentence. I will read the words in the row. Which word makes the sentence sound right?"

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	Listen: "Now I ____." Read the words: run, ran, will. Which word makes the sentence sound right?	run
b	Listen: "Yesterday I ____." Read the words: jump, jumped, will. Which word makes the sentence sound right?	jumped
c	Listen: "Tomorrow I ____ hop." Read the words: hop, hopped, will. Which word makes the sentence sound right?	will

PART 2 • MATCH TIME

SAY "Look at the time words on the left and the word choices on the right. Read the words with me, then draw each line to make these sentence starters make sense: "Today I ____." "Yesterday I ____." "Tomorrow I ____ clap.""

- **Today** matches **clap**
- **Yesterday** matches **clapped**
- **Tomorrow** matches **will**
