HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE

Read each clue and each printed word aloud so students can listen for meaning. Students show vocabulary understanding by circling the word that fits and matching words with related meanings.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

PART 1 • CIRCLE IT

SAY “Listen to my clue. I will read the big words in each row. Which word matches the clue? Circle it.”

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	I see huge, tiny, loud. Which word means very small?	tiny
b	I see ask, show, predict. Which word tells what you think will happen?	predict
c	I see habitat, weather, animal. Which science word names the place where an animal lives?	habitat

PART 2 • MATCH WORDS

SAY “Say each left word after me: tiny, predict, habitat. Now listen as I read the words on the right: home, small, guess. Draw a line from each left word to the word that means the same thing.”

- **tiny** matches **small**
- **predict** matches **guess**
- **habitat** matches **home**

WHAT TO ACCEPT

Part 1 answers are tiny, predict, and habitat. Part 2 matches are tiny-small, predict-guess, and habitat-home; accept clear lines that show these matches.
