HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE

Read each short text and its choices aloud, then give students time to circle one answer. Students use a familiar idea to notice a new detail, then use the text to check an idea that does not match what was said.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

PART 1 • NEW LEARNING

SAY “You will hear a short text in each row. Think about what you may already know, then listen for one new detail. Circle your answer after I read the choices.”

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	Listen: “Bees visit flowers to find nectar.” You may already know that bees fly. What new thing does this text tell you bees visit? I will read the choices: flowers, water, caves. Circle the new word you hear.	flowers
b	Listen: “A turtle carries its shell on its back.” You may know that turtles move slowly. What does this text tell you a turtle carries? I will read the choices: tail, shell, wing. Circle the word from the text.	shell

PART 2 • CHECK IDEAS

SAY “Sometimes an idea does not match the text. Listen closely and use the text to check each idea. Circle the word that helps you check it.”

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	Listen: “Owls sleep in the day and hunt at night.” Someone says, “Owls hunt in the day.” Which word tells when owls hunt in the text? I will read the choices: day, night, morning. Circle the word from the text.	night
b	Listen: “A seed needs water and light to grow.” Someone says, “A seed can grow with no water.” Which word from the text helps check that idea? I will read the choices: water, sand, snow. Circle the word from the text.	water

WHAT TO ACCEPT

New Learning answers are flowers and shell. Check Ideas answers are night and water; accept a clearly marked circle around the correct word.
