HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE

Read the title and passage aloud exactly as scripted. Students use the title before reading, listen for details during reading, and listen again before answering questions after reading.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

PART 1 • GET READY

SAY “Listen to the title, A Seed Grows. Use the title first, then listen closely when I read the passage.”

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	Which word best fits the title A Seed Grows? I will read the choices: sleep, swim, grow. Circle the word that fits the title.	grow
b	Listen to the passage. Mia plants a bean seed in soil. Each day, she gives it water. After many days, a green sprout pushes up. Mia sets the cup by a sunny window so the sprout can get light. She thinks it will grow tall. What did Mia give the seed each day? I will read the choices: soil, water, light. Circle the word that answers the question.	water

PART 2 • READ AGAIN

SAY “I will read the passage again. Listen for what happened and why Mia moved the cup.”

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	Mia plants a bean seed in soil. Each day, she gives it water. After many days, a green sprout pushes up. Mia sets the cup by a sunny window so the sprout can get light. What pushed up after many days? I will read the choices: cup, sprout, seed. Circle the word that answers the question.	sprout
b	Why did Mia set the cup by a sunny window? I will read the choices: water, soil, light. Circle the word that answers the question.	light

WHAT TO ACCEPT

Accept circles on grow, water, sprout, and light, in that order. Read the choices aloud for every row and reread the passage when needed.
