HOW TO RUN THIS PAGE

Read each short text aloud twice. Students listen for a character's spoken words or for the narrator's story words, then mark who is speaking or telling at that point.

Students never read directions on this sheet. Read each part's script aloud, then each prompt, giving think time before students mark.

PART 1 • LISTEN CIRCLE

SAY “Will you listen to this short story? Mia and Ben walked to the gate. Mia said, “I see a red kite.” Ben asked, “Can we watch it?” Ben smiled. Can you listen for who speaks and who tells?”

ROW	SAY	STUDENTS CIRCLE
a	The words are, “I see a red kite.” The choices are Mia, Ben, and Narrator. Who is speaking? Which word should you circle?	Mia
b	The words are, “Ben smiled.” The choices are Mia, Ben, and Narrator. Who is telling this part of the story? Which word should you circle?	Narrator
c	The words are, “Can we watch it?” The choices are Mia, Ben, and Narrator. Who is speaking? Which word should you circle?	Ben

PART 2 • MATCH VOICES

SAY “Will you listen to another short story? Ana said, “Look!” Omar said, “Wait!” The narrator tells, “Ana and Omar walked.” Can you draw a line from each name to the story word that goes with it?”

- **Ana** matches **Look**
- **Omar** matches **Wait**
- **Narrator** matches **walked**

WHAT TO ACCEPT

Part 1 answers are Mia, Narrator, and Ben. In Part 2, accept Ana to Look, Omar to Wait, and Narrator to walked.
