- **PARALLEL:** The mechanic inspected the engine, replaced the filter, and tested the brakes.

Challenge: The internship requires careful planning, clear communication, and reliable attendance.

Answers: 1, 2, 4, and 7 are PARALLEL; 3, 5, 6, and 8 are MIXED. For Part 2, students should name the grammatical forms that match or shift; accept varied challenge revisions if all three elements share one form.
