Maya Watches Butterflies

- ① On a sunny morning, Maya visited the school garden. A yellow butterfly rested on a purple flower. Maya stood still so she would not scare it away. She watched its wings open and close.
- ② Butterflies use a long mouthpart called a proboscis to sip nectar from flowers. Maya first read proboscis slowly. Then she looked at the next words, "to sip nectar," and read the whole sentence again.
- ③ Later, Maya wrote what she learned in her notebook. "Flowers give butterflies nectar," she wrote. She reread her sentence and checked each word. Her careful reading helped her make sure her note matched what she saw.
