Busy Beavers

- ① Beavers build homes called lodges near ponds and streams. They use sticks, mud, and rocks. A lodge has an underwater door, which helps keep the beaver safe from many land animals. Families rest inside the lodge.
- ② Beavers also build dams across moving water. The dams slow the water and can make a pond. In a pond, beavers can swim, find food, and carry branches to their lodge more easily.
- ③ Young beavers stay with their parents for about two years. During that time, they learn to swim and help with the lodge. When they are older, they leave to make a home of their own.
