Beavers Build Homes

- ① Beavers are busy animals that live near ponds and streams. They use their wide, flat tails to swim and warn others of danger. A beaver's home is called a lodge, a shelter built from sticks and mud.
- ② A beaver may build a dam across moving water. A dam is a wall that slows water and can make a pond. In the pond, the beaver can find food and stay safer from some predators.
- ③ Scientists observe beavers to learn how animals change habitats. Observe means to watch closely and notice details. A habitat is a place where a plant or animal lives. Beaver dams can create wet places for frogs, fish, and birds.
