Bees in the Garden

- ① On Tuesday, Maya's class visited the school garden. They saw bees move from flower to flower. Ms. Chen asked students to observe the bees carefully. Each student wrote notes about the insects' bodies, colors, and actions.
- ② Later, Maya shared her notes with a partner. She said, "Bees collect nectar from flowers." Her partner said, "Let's compare the two insects." The children compared a bee's fuzzy body with a butterfly's smooth body.
- ③ For the garden display, the class made a sign. It read, "Protect pollinators. Plant flowers for food and shelter." Pollinators are animals, such as bees, that carry pollen between flowers. Families stopped to read the helpful message.
